



Statement of Compliance with the REACH - Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) Regulations aim to:

- Provide a high level of protection for human health and the environment
- Make manufacturers and importers responsible for managing risk
- Allow free movement of substances on the EU market
- Enhance the competitiveness of the EU chemicals industry
- Promote alternative methods for the assessment of hazard

Also

- Requires manufacturers and importers to gather hazard information and assess risk
- Can require the use of some particularly hazardous substances to be authorised
- Restricts the marketing and use of certain chemicals

We confirm that to the best of our knowledge, products supplied by the main suppliers of Mecatix SA comply with REACH regulations. They do not contain any of the listed Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) - as shown on the initial Candidate list dated 28th October 2008, including additional new substances detailed by the 18th June 2010 up-date, and the latest up-date to 191 substances published 27th June 2018.

REACH is the European Union's legislation for the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals. This legislation affects a major part of Europe's chemical industry, importers, distributors and end users. REACH came into force on 1 June 2007 with the aim of improving the previous regulation of chemicals in the European Union. REACH places greater responsibility on the whole supply chain in order to manage the risks that chemicals may pose to human health and the environment. The European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) was established in Helsinki to supervise all the REACH processes.
